COST OF LIVING

The cost-of-living crisis is causing huge distress and suffering throughout the country. Nearly 20% of our population is now living on the margins. We have the highest cost of electricity in Europe at double the per unit

DEMANDING ACTION ON HOUSING

Cork City Council currently own 350

houses which are now vacant. Cork County Council own a further 184 vacant houses. The greatest hoarder of vacant properties in this country is the State itself. In the jaws of a housing crisis, this is a disgrace. These homes should immediately be brought back into use.

The average length of time to turn around, and to relet these vacant Local Authority homes is 8 months. This is far too long. The average length of turn around for a private rental home is 3 weeks. As your Councillor Anna will not tolerate this and will fight tooth and nail to ensure Local Authority Homes houses are turned around in 4 weeks or less.

Aontú will build more Local Authority homes. We will reform the planning system. We will ban Air BnB short term lets in urbans areas. Tourists are staying in homes and families are forced to remain in hotels for years. This makes no sense.

GOVERNMENT POLICY IS BAD FOR YOUR HEALTH

Aontú has found out that almost 500,000 people have been injured in the Irish Health Service since 2018. Shockingly

3,142 people have died as a result of these mistakes. Staffing levels have collapsed in the Health service and so much pressure is being put on the remaining staff that its harming patient and staff welfare.

Incredibly last year 115,000 patients across the country left A&Es without being seen. That's 115,000 people who were sick enough to warrant going to the A&E but were forced to wait so long that they walked out without treatment. Many ambulances are being forced to wait for hours to deliver their patients to A&Es because of overcrowding. This has led to an increase in 22% in just 3 years of the number of patients who were dead before the arrival of the ambulance.

HSE is top heavy with management, yet it can't make a decision. It is swallowing public money without increasing services to patients. Anna Daly is the member of the National Hospital Campaign and will continue to fight for the reform and proper funding of the Health Service.

CRIME AND ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR ON THE INCREASE

Many citizens are in fear not just at nighttime, but even in the

middle of the day. Restaurants are closing earlier in the evening for the fear of attacks and violence. Children are being mugged for money and their phones on the way home from school. Lanes off main streets are off limits due to open drinking and drug-taking.



Communities, especially in working class areas feel under siege due to the increase in crime and anti-social behaviour. Sexual assault has doubled in 10 years. Rape has doubled in 10 years. Serious unprovoked attacks are now commonplace. Yet until recently this crisis did not feature at all on the government's radar. Every year that Helen McEntee has been the Minister for Justice, the number of Gardaí has fallen.

Indeed, we have one of the lowest numbers of police per capita in EU. Every year hundreds of Garda are being attacked. Every year hundreds of Gardaí are resigning and retiring. Garda morale is on the floor. Recruitment to Templemore has collapsed.

Aontú has raised with the Government time and again the need for

more Garda officers to be retained. We have introduced legislation to protect Garda welfare. Our legislation would ensure an automatic custodial sentence for anyone assaulting a Garda or emergency services personnel.

FIGHTING BACK AGAINST THE CULTURE WARS

Aontú campaigned to ensure that women were not written out of the Work Life Balance Bill which reduced women to 'persons' in relation to maternity protections. The Bill would have removed the terms 'women', 'female' and 'mother' in maternity legislation.

We are the only party that brought this issue successfully to Councils seeking



to ensure that women would not be written out of future legislation. We have also pushed back against Government efforts to put gender ideology into SPHE classes in school.

Anna believes that parents must be listened to when it comes to their children's education. SPHE classes should be based on science and fact and not on political ideology.
